Strain Description :

Saccharomyces boulardii is a strain of yeast which has been extensively studied for its probiotic effects, helps in intestinal comfort and contributes to maintain the intestinal flora. Besides, all live yeast cannot be considered as probiotics. To be eligible for this designation, the strain must survive GI transit (gastric acid and bile salts), be viable and stable in the host and confer a proven health benefit. Saccharomyces boulardii meets the requirements for probiotics.
